

Grades are earned:

Students will be evaluated off of proficiency scales based on music ensemble standards. These scales will be presented to students in class but will also be posted onto our website as they are developed. the following grading scale will be used and submitted into the gradebook under the following categories: **Creating, Performing, Responding & Connecting** which are the four strands of music standards. Below is the rubric for grading using the scales.



****Attendance at Performances:**

Performances are important. It is the final product of hours, days, and weeks of hard work and practice. Each performance is worth 100 points. **ALL PERFORMANCES ARE MANDATORY!** A performance missed without a legitimate excuse will result in a 0 for the concert grade. A student with a legitimate excuse will be allowed to make up the grade by completing a designated assignment that will be due within <u>one week</u> after the performance. A calendar of dates can be found on the music website, as well as attached to this document; I will send changes out as soon as I can if needed. Performances include concerts, festivals, and other functions that each performing ensemble is required to attend. If you are going to miss a performance, please notify me as soon as you can. If it is not an emergency, I must be informed with a legitimate reason for missing a performance <u>at least one day in advance</u>. If it is a family emergency, please call me as soon as possible and let me know.

****Concert Dress:**

Concert attire is important. A great Ensemble not only sounds good but also looks good. The concert attire for choir groups is all black (preferably nicer than everyday clothes) including shoes, and I will provide a scarf or tie that matches the class color. Day time performances or more casual performances for choir students will be their Music shirts and black pants (no rips or tears).

All Musical Theatre classes will wear Music shirts and black pants at CMS Concerts. Advanced Musical Theatre will be required to provide some costume pieces for their Spring Musical (show TBA).

Music Shirts are Navy blue with white writing (says Carson Middle School Music Department) and it is the same for all music ensembles, you only need one, so if you have one from last year or from another ensemble you can use it for this class as well.

Tri M Honor Society:

Adv Musical Theatre Spring Musical

This year the Advanced Musical Theatre class will be putting on a full musical. This will be many of the students first opportunity to participate in a full musical. We have not chosen the musical yet but will announce it very soon. Once we have a show students will audition for their parts though all students will participate in some way. This is a great opportunity for students to see how a show is put together from finances, to sets and props to learning all the lyrics and lines. We will have two performances of this performances, Thursday April 25th and Friday April 26th both at 7:00 pm. There will be two after school rehearsals wednesday the 24th and thursday the 25th. Please mark your calendars now so we do not have conflicts for this event.

Class Dojo

In support of our schools positive behavior plan and rewarding students for their hard work we are going to be using Class Dojo in classes this year. Most of you are probably better acquainted with this program than I am so please help me as we go along. Students will earn Class Dojo points for being on task, helping others, receiving 100% on a test or quiz as well as other things. They can also loose points for not participating, chewing gum, late assignments, ect. Points can then be "CASHED OUT" on the last Friday of the month for prizes. Students can earn prizes like pencils and stickers as well as homework passes and getting to choose their seat in class for the day. This is a working program so we will change it as we see a need but I am excited to get to celebrate the students successes in class.
